Hi Ladies –

The ‘Magnolias’ taught by Lisa Fox are really beautiful. In addition to teaching the workshop, Lisa demonstrated the use of the light box and its versatility. It will be interesting to see how many future projects include the use of the thick acrylic paint and webbing spray that Lisa used. This is a very interesting technique. Thanks for a very informative class, Lisa, as well as all you do. Great class!!

The September 7<sup>th</sup> Workshop, features an original design of a ‘Koi Pond’ taught by Cindy Makowski. This project uses acrylics for the under painting. Oil paints will then be used to float over the under painting for shading and highlighting. This same technique can be used on other paintings you have already done to really bring them to life. It’s a wonderful technique to have in your painting toolbox. Cindy will be supplying the paints for this project.

September’s 15-minute, mini-class will focus on the use of your brushes – flats, liners, rounds and filberts. Diane Foreman will be teaching this class.

Lee thanked everyone for sending get well wishes during her illness.

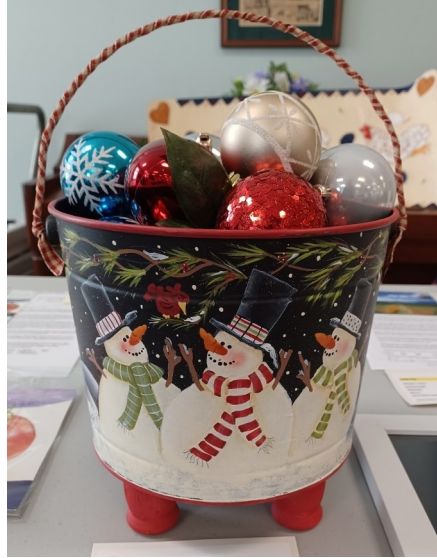

PCDA will pay-\$12 per registered student to the teacher. If there are twelve (12) or fewer registered participants, the Workshop may be canceled by agreement with the teacher. In the event of such a cancellation, NO fee will be paid to the teacher. If the teacher decides to hold the Workshop with twelve (12) or fewer participants, the teacher will be paid a flat fee of \$144.00.

Teacher will provide Workshop Chair with a minimum of 15 Prep Packets or more if requested by Workshop Chair, up to the class *size* limit, three (3) months prior to class. The Prep Packets must include a list of supplies, the line drawing, special needs, prep instruction sheet, and a colored picture of the prepped project for each student. At class time, teacher will supply each student with a pattern packet that must include a colored picture of the completed project (if not provided previously) and detailed instructions for completion of the project.

If this is not an original design, the teacher must indicate the artist's name and source of the design on the instruction sheet. It is the teacher's responsibility to obtain the artist's written permission. The cost of reproduction services will be absorbed by the teacher. If a special surface is required or must be ordered, the estimated cost and availability of the surface will be indicated in advance. If the teacher cancels the Workshop after students have paid for surfaces/ supplies SOLD by that teacher for that class, the teacher will refund those supply costs paid by the students. The teacher is expected to bring one set of paints and any mediums used for the Workshop. CAMERA/AUDIO EQUIPMENT IS AVAILABLE AND THE TEACHER IS REQUESTED TO MAKE USE OF IT.

NOTE: Please DO NOT specify any paint color or item that has been discontinued. If an original paint color has been discontinued, the teacher must furnish the name of a replacement color(s) or mixing formulae. Also, PLEASE DO NOT submit any project that has been taught to any Club in our area within the past five (5) years.

Club meetings and Workshops are usually the first Saturday of the month. The teacher will determine the maximum number of students in a Workshop. Workshops will last 4-5 hours starting no later than 10:00 a.m. (after Club's business meeting) and ending no later than 4:00 p.m. with a 30-minute lunch break. The teacher will receive a list of registered students (2) days prior to class.

Submissions for consideration must be received by the Workshop Chair between September 15<sup>th</sup> and October 20<sup>th</sup>, and include this completed form, color photo, and a list of any special needs and their estimated cost. After receipt of the proposed projects, the Board will review them for voting by members at the November Club meeting. Teachers will be notified and a mutually convenient Workshop schedule will be planned.
